Voting Requirements:

Forewarned is forearmed; so take note. You must be a member in good standing or be a new member signing up by Noon Tuesday, June 9th, 2009 to have the right to vote in the election of new officers on the Board of Directors.

Voting Procedures:

Voting can be done by absentee ballot if necessary. The ballot on the insert must be completed and put in an unmarked envelope inside an envelope addressed to the Center and marked "Election" in the lower left corner. The outside envelope must have your name and address on it so that we can check you off on our membership list. These

ballots must be postmarked by June 3rd, 2009 or hand delivered to the Center by close of business (4pm.) Monday, June 8th, 2009.

Nominations:

Nominations will be accepted from the floor after the opening ceremony of the meeting is finished. Nominees must be members in good standing.

The meeting begins at 4pm. sharp and no one will be admitted after the meeting commences. Please come and vote and participate in your Center's election of officers.

We presently have three candidates for the vacancies on the Board of Directors and we urge you to consider running for the Board. New Directors will be elected for a three year term 2009 - 2012 and there are ex-

pected to be three vacancies on election day. The three candidates for the Board are Valerie Brown, June Messier and Christine Tremblay. Information in their own words is available for your perusal on the insert above the absentee ballot.

We have many challenging issues (much like the country in general!) coming up in the next three years and, like the country, we will face them and solve them and rise above them. 



