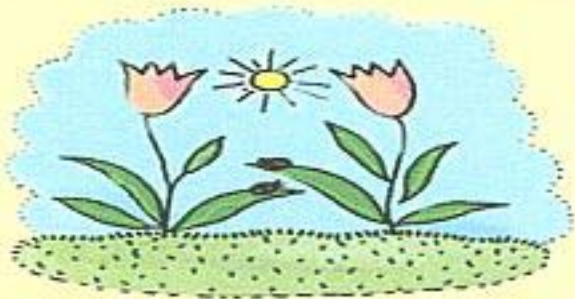

Cancellation Policy for Trips etc.

The Wells/Ogunquit Senior Center has the following Cancellation Policy concerning all trips and shows. (Show Tickets are non-refundable once we purchase them.) Transportation is by motor coach and requires a minimum number of people (varies by trip) to cover our cost. If you sign up for a trip and decide to cancel, these cancellation fees will apply to the coach portion{30 -15 days 75% refund,} {14 -8 days 50%} the last week of trip no refund. Exceptions are for medical reasons only. It is difficult to plan trips, when people sign up, then forget, or in some cases sign up twice. Seating arrangement depends on when we receive payment. If you want to sit close to the front of the bus, get the payment in asap. Exceptions are made for special needs persons.

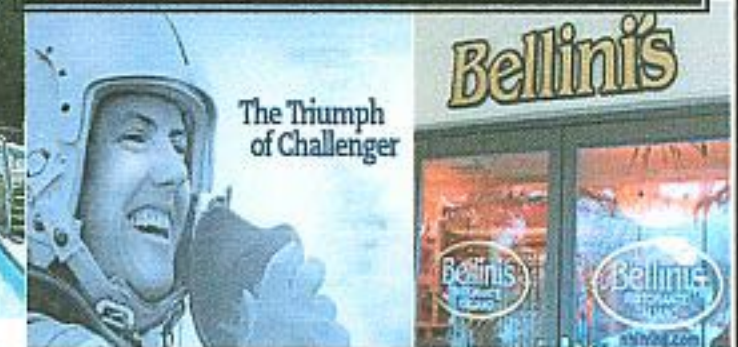
