And answering the rules of the sea, as the nearest vessel we went to the rescue. The sailboat had lost its power and was at the mercy of the tide. We stayed and assisted until the coastguard arrived and finally got home late that evening with a story that has lasted for 5 years. Obviously Bina has fond memories of that day and has shown it by donating in her mother's name. 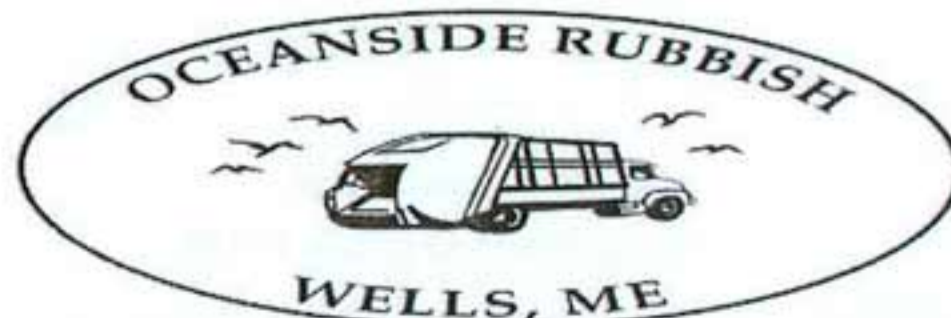

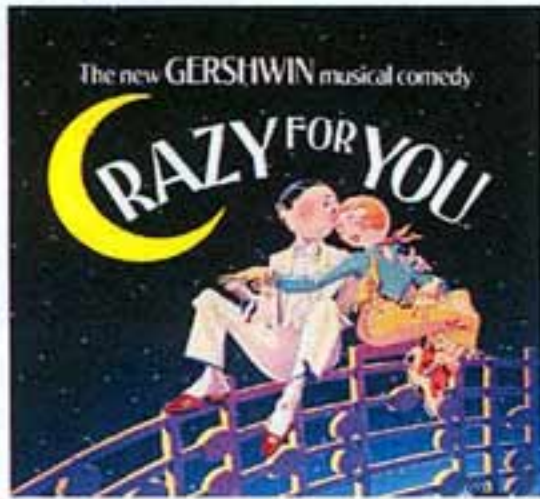
